1 REGISTER YOUR BIKE

Register your bike for <u>FREE</u> with NC State University Transportation through their online platform (transportation.ncsu.edu/bicycling)



2 LOCK YOUR BIKE

Bicycles should always be locked when not in use or under close watch of the owner. We recommend a U-Lock! Be sure to lock the front wheel and the frame of the bike to the rack.

3 RECORD BIKE'S SERIAL NUMBER

It is not always possible to prevent bike theft, but in the event your bike is stolen, you can help NCSU PD track it down.

Having your bike's serial number, make, and model can drastically increase chances of having your bike recovered!

If you are having trouble locating a serial number or want to get a free personalized engraving for your property, contact NCSU PD for assistance!

GENERAL THEFT PREVENTION TIPS:

- -Remove or hide all valuables within your vehicle prior to leaving your vehicle unattended
- -Always secure vehicles and residences prior to leaving
